

ICOMOS Thailand International Conference 2012-2013 on Asian Forgotten Heritage: Perception, Preservation and Presentation is organized as a platform for scholars, researchers and practitioners in the field of cultural heritage conservation to reexamine the issues regarding our forgotten heritage, the assessment and safeguarding of its values and the management of these irreplaceable resources.

THEMES

The conference will consider three main themes. Contributions on the following themes are welcomed:

1. Documentation and recording of forgotten heritage

Recording and documentation is a fundamental step towards the conservation of disappearing heritage. Systematic recording, historical research and documentation are essential especially when the value of the heritage is not universally recognized. This theme, therefore, explores concept of inventory and various approaches and methodologies in documenting these heritages as well as the utilisation of the recorded materials.













2. Concept and practice of the heritage conservation

The theme critically examines the challenges in striking a balance between the conservation of heritage value and the potential of the forgotten heritage to serve modern demand; the pressing problems and threats to the survival of the heritage; the emergency strategies and interventions which can protect and ensure its longevity and the presentation of its values, both tangible and intangible, through conservation effort.

3. Conservation of historic community

Many of the important sites of cultural significance in Asia are continuously inhabited. Throughout generations, these communities have evolved and changed. Most are under threat due to rapid expansion of urban development. The theme shall address the challenges and opportunities in conservation of urban and rural communities; the possible approaches to community conservation which encompasses physical elements of the communities as well as the consideration of their socio-economic and intangible cultural aspects; the management system that recognize the need for community involvement; traditional practices and indigenous knowledge in safeguarding historic community.
